UPCOMING CONSIDERATIONS & FUTURE ACTIONS

- Constantly shifting market conditions due to COVID-19
- Series C bond issuance not scheduled at this time
 - Continued follow-up from Facilities Study Sessions on project prioritization
- Timing of potential future Statewide Bond and/or local Bond

AB 75 (O'Donnell)

- 2022 K–12 and community college school facilities bond
- Unspecified election, unspecified amount
- Basic construction programs plus funding for 75-year-old facilities and lead in water remediation

SB 22 (Glazer)

- 2022 Preschool through higher education bond
- Unspecified election, \$15 billion
- Contains many of AB 48's (2020) provisions except those pertaining to developer fees
