We appreciate the support and encouragement you have shown us as we have developed the proposed Project plan.

We are requesting that the MHUSD Board of Education make a formal determination that recognizes that the Project "Charter School of Morgan Hill Additions and Modernization" is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines for Implementation, per Class 14 - Minor Additions to Schools, as it:

- Consists of minor additions to existing school within existing school grounds.
- The addition does not increase original student capacity by more than 25% or ten classrooms:
 - Maximum enrollment capacity of 648 will remain unchanged.
 - The Project does not increase the number of classrooms.
- This Project is not a small part of a larger project requiring environmental review or one of a successive series of projects of similar type that have a cumulative effect requiring environmental review.
- The Project does not damage scenic resources, is not in a hazardous waste site, or does it cause substantial adverse change in any historical resource.
