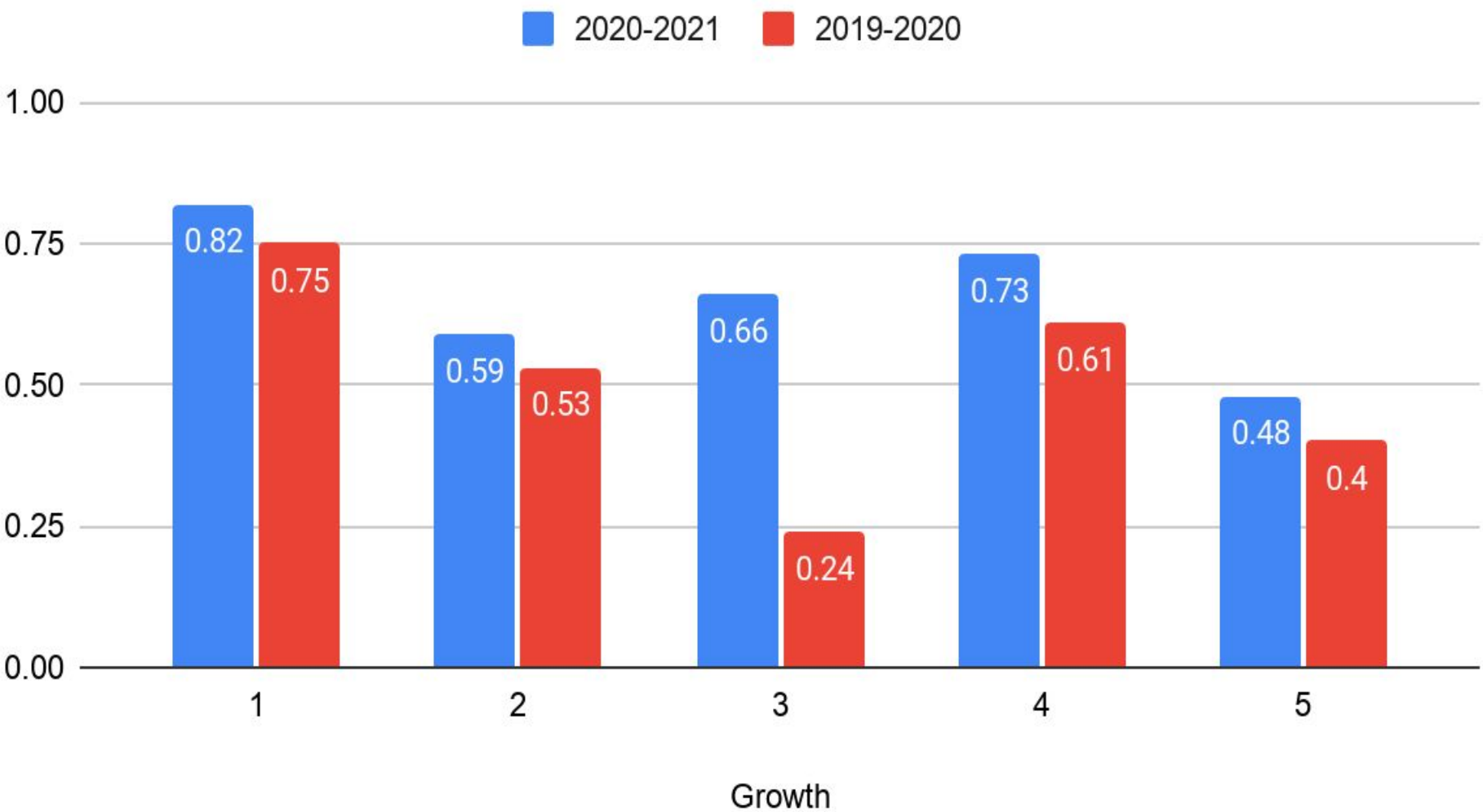

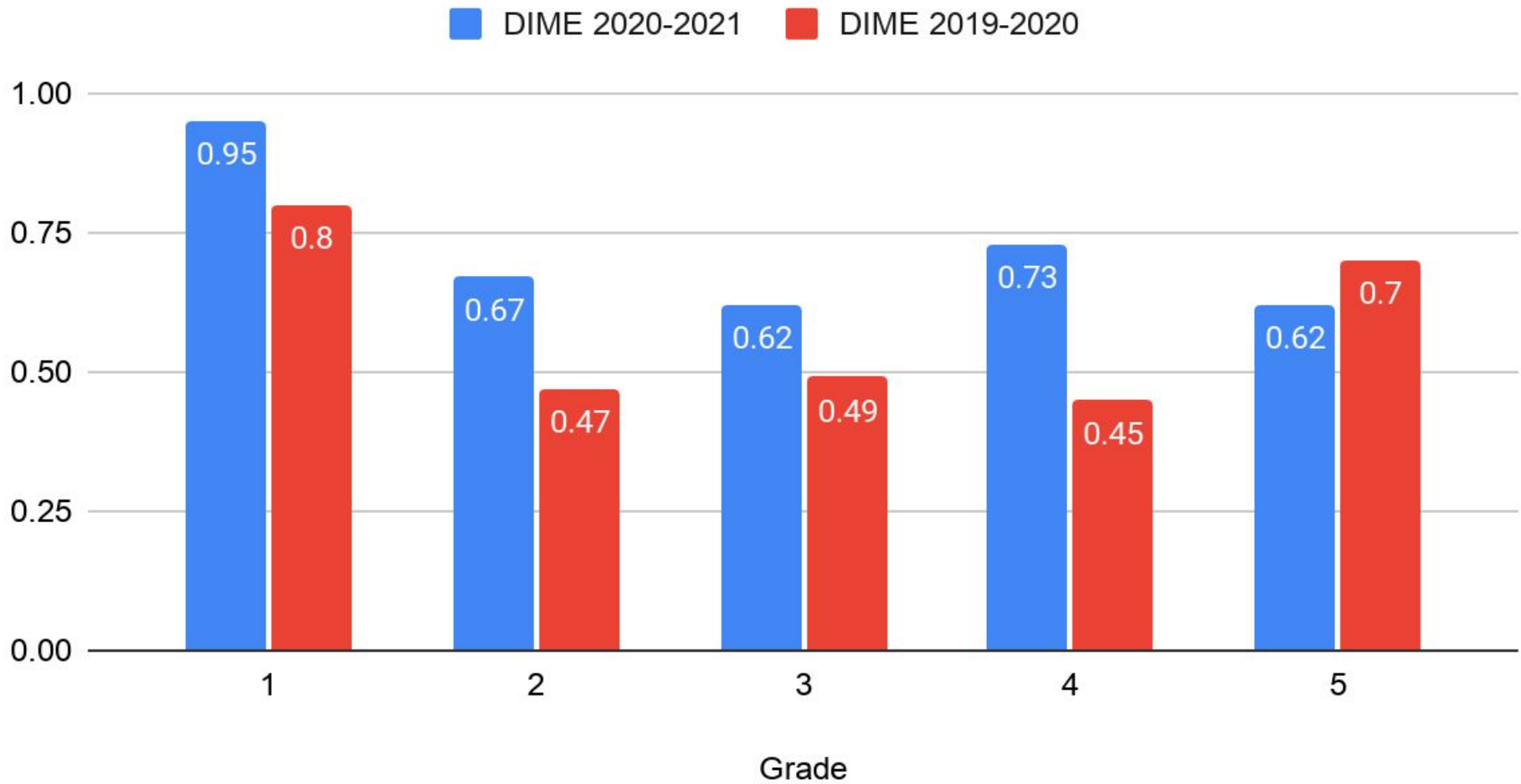

What's new with CTE?

- *Following CDE's [rubric for a High Quality CTE Program](#) (linked), MHUSD has focused their efforts over the last 2 years in the following areas:*
 - **Work Based Learning (WBL) plans for each program**
 - **Certifications for ALL capstone courses**
 - **Sequential alignment of all pathway courses, including sequential enrollment in courses for all students**
 - **Supporting high quality, first instruction with updated learning materials, equipment and supplies**
 - **Expanding student participation in Career Technical Student Organizations (CTSOs), like FFA and SkillsUSA**

What does WBL look like?

Example: Live Oak Construction Tech class is building a mock home structure, starting with the subfloor to learn about framing (pictured). By the end of the school year they will have added framed walls and installed plumbing, HVAC and electrical. - Teacher, CJ Goularte

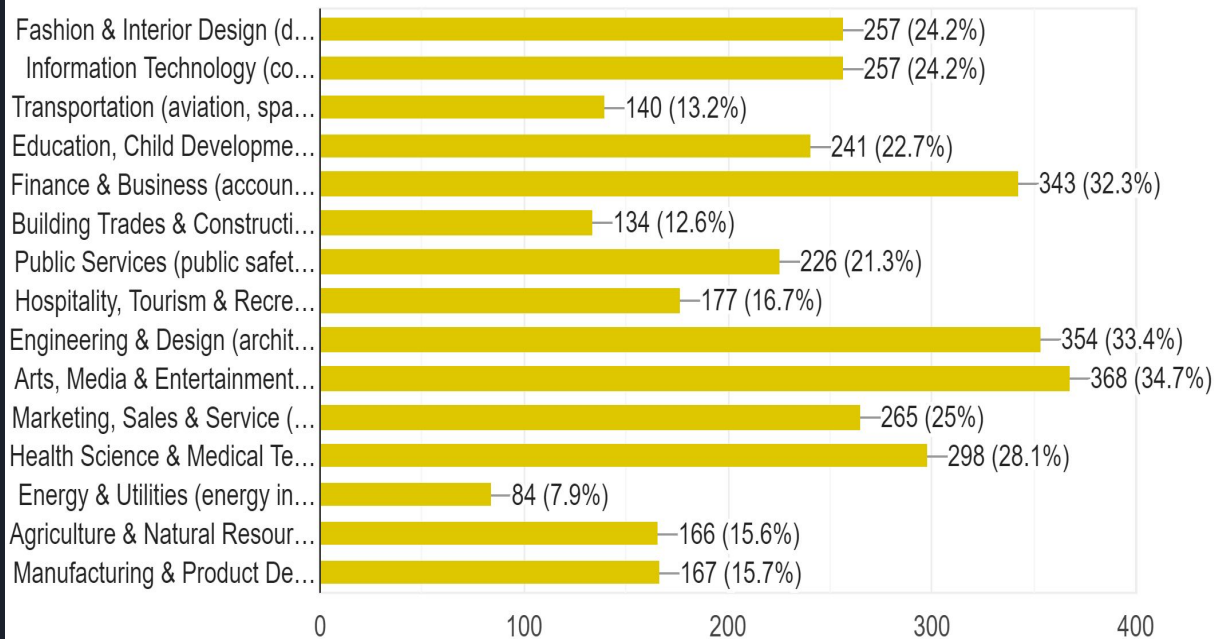


What did MHUSD high school students say about their interests?
