**WHEREAS**, the Morgan Hill Unified School District (MHUSD) is proud to recognize National Hispanic Heritage Month; and

**WHEREAS**, every year, since 1968, from September 15 to October 15 our country has celebrated Hispanic and Latino/x culture, history, heritage and contributions to our community and nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2021 theme for National Hispanic Heritage Month: *Esperanza: A Celebration of Hispanic Heritage and Hope*, invites us to celebrate Hispanic Heritage and to reflect on how great our tomorrow can be if we hold onto our resilience and hope. **WHEREAS**, the Morgan Hill Unified School District in its continued effort to honor National Hispanic Heritage Month and to enhance equity and diversity, remains dedicated to providing resources and programming for Spanish speaking communities; offers translation services and training for teachers/schools and continues recruitment efforts to attract diverse educators into the teaching profession; promotes multilingual education through our dual immersion program and involvement with the California Association of Bilingual Education (CABE); and

**WHEREAS**, in resonance with the 2021 theme of *Esperanza: A Celebration of Hispanic Heritage and Hope*, the Morgan Hill Unified School District recognizes the significant contributions and considerable advances that Hispanic Americans have made and continue to make each and every day in our community, state and the world, as leaders, politicians, educators, and public servants.
