**1. (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) Robotics Central Valley Regional Competition- Seaside)**

**Dates: Wednesday, March 23 - Saturday, March 26, 2022**

The purpose of the trip is to work on the robot in the competition, and learn how to trouble-shoot and work as a team. **Dates: Saturday, March 26 - Tuesday, March 29, 2022**

The overall purpose of the conference is leadership development and enhancement around issues and concerns for agriculture students throughout the state of California. The entire team will stay at a local hotel in Sacramento along with other participating FFA groups, as arranged by the agriculture teachers with help from the Sobrato Ag Boosters. **4. CA Association of Directors of Activities (CADA) Student Leaders Leadership Conference in Ontario, CA.**

**Dates: April 2 - April 4, 2022**

Students from Sobrato High School wish to participate in a leadership conference with CADA, the largest statewide support network for Activity Directors and Student Leaders in the nation, to provide a powerful experience in leadership development. Approximately 12 ASHS students and 2 ASHS staff will travel to Ontario, California to participate in the statewide conference. During the 3-day program, students are involved in seminars and lectures, workshops and activities. Themes include leadership, self-worth, setting goals, self-identification and personal growth. Lodging, food, transportation to and from the venue and all workshops are included. All activities and accommodations are prepared by the CADA staff who accompany chaperones and students daily. Students will pay between \$200-300 for their trip after our ASB program pays for half of their program fees. The trips are organized outside of school resources, substitute coverage and transportation costs will be paid for by ASB. The trip takes place from Saturday, April 2 to Monday, April 4. Attending students and staff will miss one day of school on Monday, April 4. There is no cost to the district.
