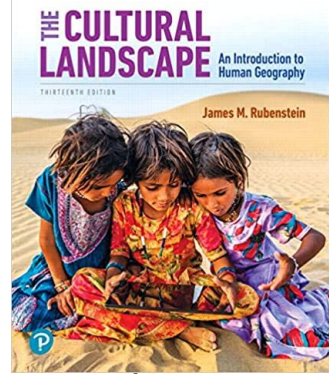


AP Human Geography Textbook Adoption Recommendation



- Recommended textbook adoption: The Cultural Landscape-Human Geography by James Rubenstein
- This is the most used and recommended textbook for the AP Human Geography course, and is the textbook used in the College Board syllabus we are adopting for our course audit.
- Strengths of the textbook include:
 - Content is delivered in a challenging yet accessible way. College-level academic vocabulary and content is used throughout, while keeping the information concise and direct so as not to overwhelm students. The textbook is less than 500 pages.
 - Each page has visual aids, including maps, graphs, charts, pictures, etc. for students to analyze. These each come with captions and/or questions for students to reference to deepen learning.
 - Skills support, like writing and analysis tasks, is included in every chapter, chapter review, and unit review.
 - Teacher materials include a bank of exam questions and writing tasks, in addition to lesson plans, video links, and additional sources for students to analyze.
 - Students and teachers will have access to the textbook and support materials online.
 - The publisher is Pearson/Savvas, which is the same publisher as our core Social Studies textbooks! Seamless transition =)
