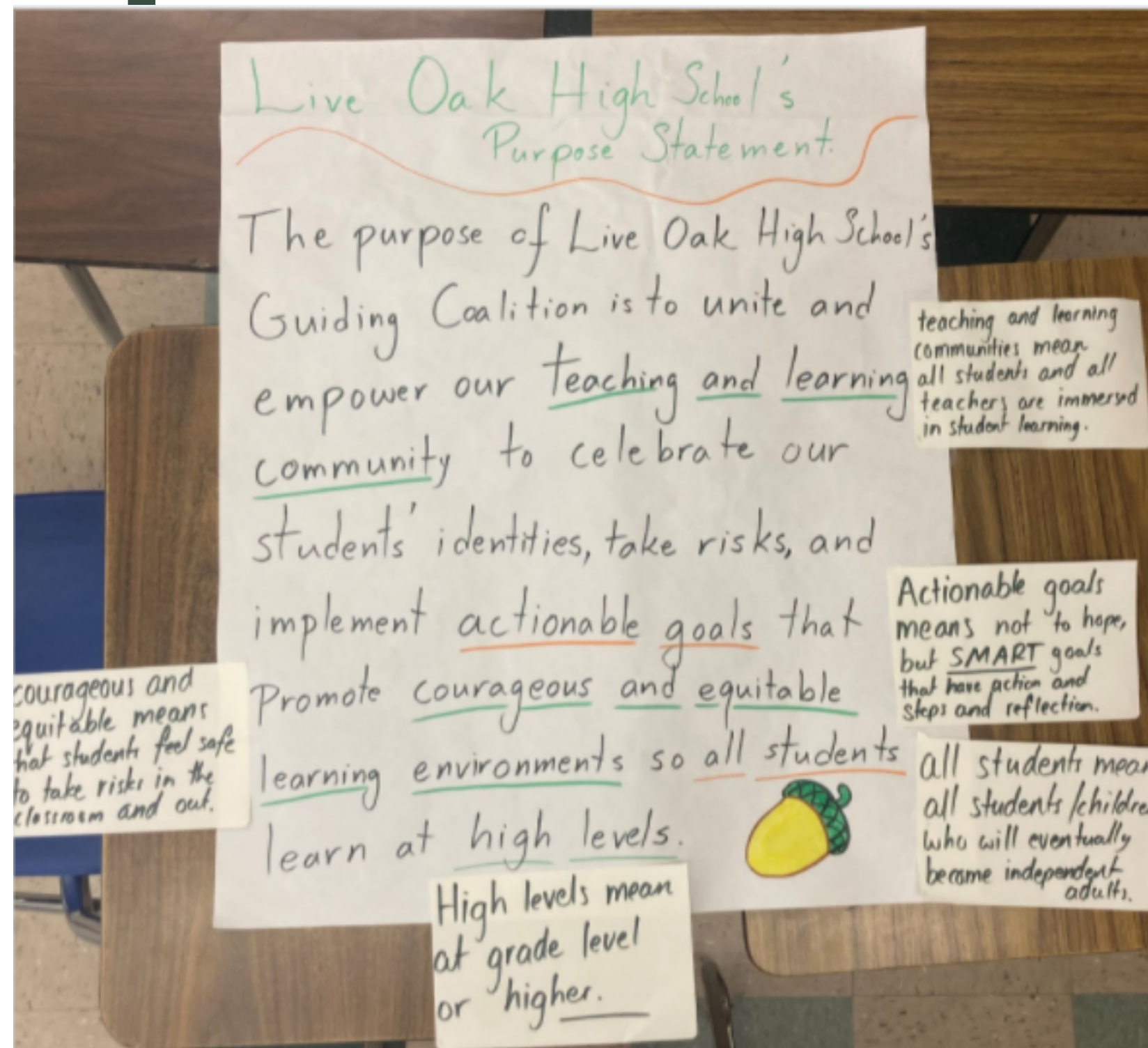

 - In 2023-2024, we could have our first class of AP Capstone graduates!
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
CTE

- Athletics

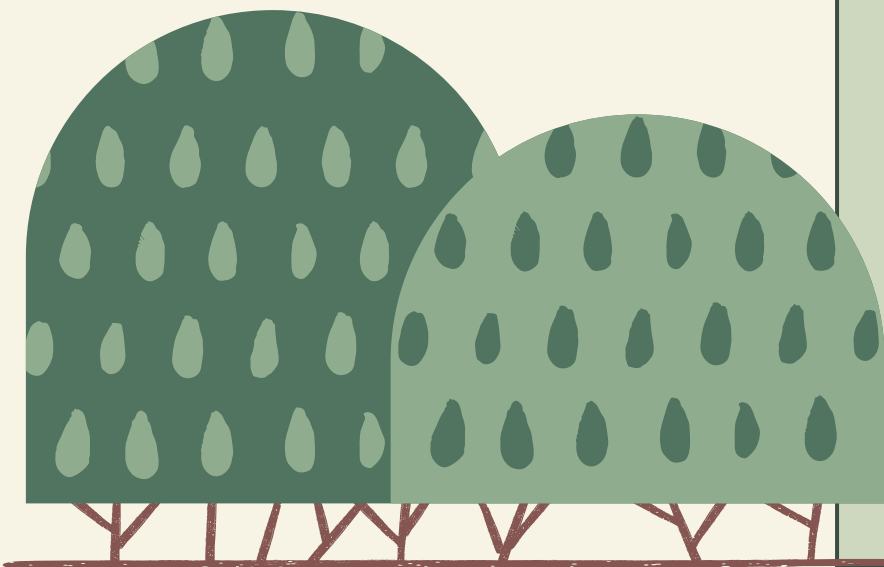
Student Voice Opportunity

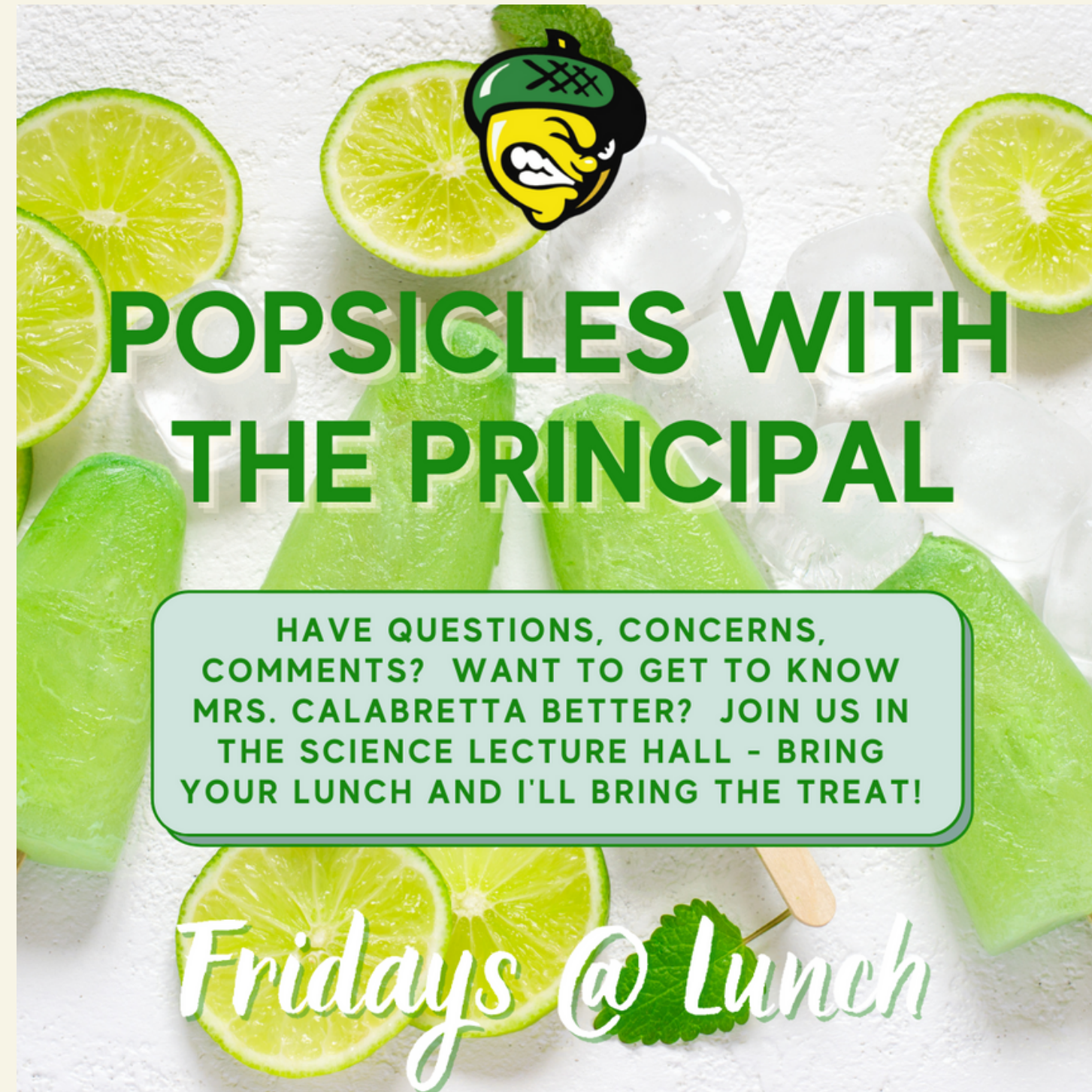

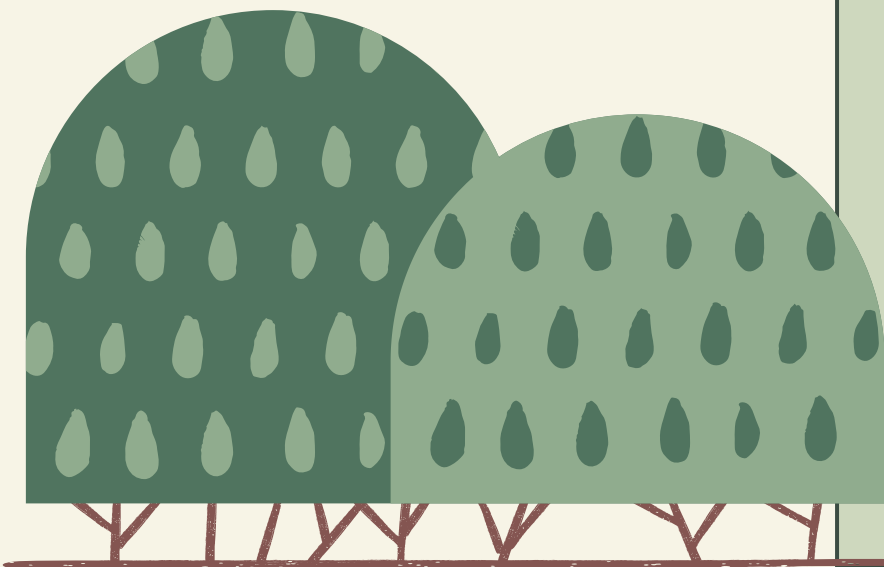
New Student Supports

CREDIT RECOVERY TUTORIAL

- 9th and 20th grade students identified as credit deficient from fall semester
- 4 teachers stipended to oversee 1 tutorial per week
- Students assigned to a day of the week for a tutorial to work on credit recovery

HOMEWORK CENTER

- two staff members stipended to cover one hour Mon-Thurs in the library
- Provide supervision, tutoring and a safe place after scho

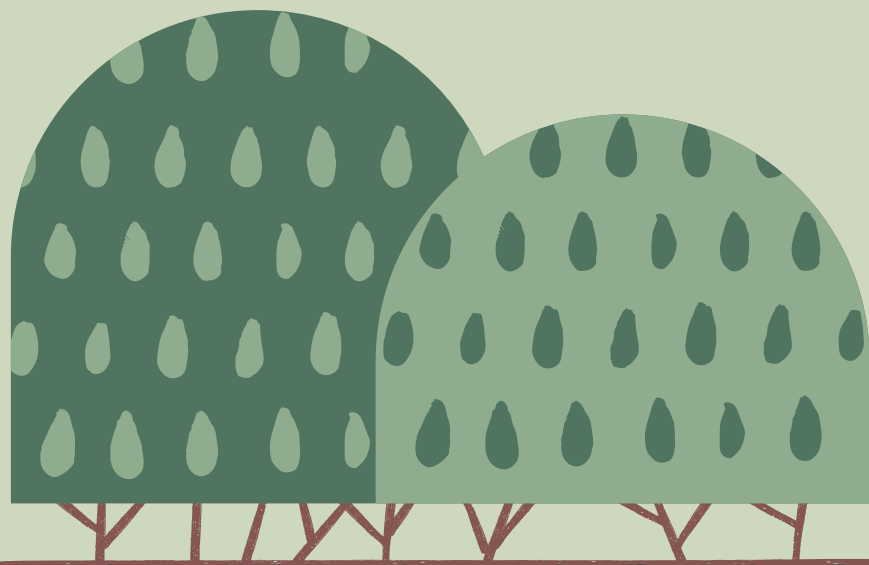
