Article 4 – Compensation

To improve salary in order to attract and retain high quality, well trained teachers, counselors, librarians, nurses, and speech language pathologists to serve our students and families.

Article 6 - Retirement Options

To explore retirement options for members who, because they entered CALSTRS after January 1, 2013, cannot participate in Retirement Option IV.

Article 9 - Health & Welfare Benefits

To provide options that meet the differing health & welfare needs of our members and their families.

Article 12 – Hours of Employment

To clarify and add language to ensure that work requirements for all members are represented in contract language.

Article 15 - Class Size

To modify and add class size/case load language to ensure that every student and their needs are known and met in our schools.
