The service is ad-free and archives videos. The price is \$100 per month. However, soon moving to Youtube free services in the next couple of board meetings. Used a vendor, Troxell to install the mics and the tech director to support the broadcast, double check everything and turn on the live stream for the meeting. Video recordings kept as record permanently.
